## **PRESS RELEASE**

“Viaggio Continuo” (Continuous travel), the title that Paolo Mussat Sartor chose for the catalogue of his solo exhibition at GAM in Turin, leads to the meaning he wants to give to photography; a route of images, in space and time, that identifies itself with his own existence and that we are asked to follow with “his eyes” from 1968, when his collaboration with Gian Enzo Sperone Gallery begins. For the following decade he has been photographing the works, performances and artists, in Italy and Europe, from Conceptual Art and Arte Povera; this part of his work will be documented by the publication of the book “1968-1978 Art and artists in Italy” in 1979 by Stampatori Editori. Since the first 70’s he has been parallelly producing a series of photographs (still lives 1973, multiplied snapshots 1973-1976, travels since 1975...) that brings him to the realization of “Che fare” in 1984, a meditation on the idea at the basis of his work.

In 1985 he decided to intervene in the photographic printing process with coloured pigments.

Portraits, still lives, roses, legs, stones, figures and asymmetrical figures are part of his art work realized between 1985 and 2006 with this personal technique.

In the present exhibition at Tucci Russo, Studio per l’Arte Contemporanea, he shows “Che fare” 1984 and two series of big size works, never shown before, that continue his search on this technique: “La Montagna”, 2006 e “La città”, 2009.

In the first series he documents the performance of the nature itself, as a spectator in front of a big scenography .

In the second one the photographer is moving among the skyscrapers of New York.
